

Dear Family, in class today, we tinkered with a camera and took some photographs.

Did you know?

- A photograph shows a moment in time.
- A photograph can hint that a thing is moving.
- Children like hands-on activities.
- Children can talk about these experiences.

Ask your child:

- Explain what a camera is used for.
- Tell me what you did with a camera.
- Describe your photograph.

Vocabulary:

- digital – a type of information. It comes from a signal. The signal is electronic.
- camera – a tool. It makes photographs.
- movement – a motion.
- photography – the art of making pictures. The pictures are made by a camera.
- flight – the act of moving through the air.
- research – a study. It is done to find information about something.

Activity:

Help your child to look around your home for photographs. Discuss who or what is in the photos. Talk about who might have taken the photos. Allow your child to choose a photo to share with us. Place it in a re-sealable bag, and label it with your child's name before sending it to school.
