A lot of times I get clients from different countries and a lot of times they feel intimidated to go up to a bank because they might not be able to speak English or they might not understand how banking works here in the United States.

My name is Louis Malebranche and I'm a banker at the PNC Mobile branch. Because I'm trilingual and French, Creole and English, it makes my job a little bit easier. I've been able to bond with some people that had some barriers of languages and when you can greet them in their native language, it's already making the process very easy. And I think they do appreciate that we're so we're so diverse so that they can know that if they want someone in a different language, they can get assistance.

#### Keris Engle, President and CEO, The Glades Initiative, Inc.:

The Glades Initiative is all about connecting people to Health and Human services here in the Glades community. Our missions to improve the coordination and effectiveness of the system of care. Our key programs really are the navigation assistance that we provide to people and that's to help them with online applications. We have a large food program. We provide food to

over 700 households every week. When our residents come for the food, it's a really great opportunity for them to come and access the mobile unit that PNC brings on site.

They can get the financial training and the literacy, but they we also have the chance to speak one-on-one to one of the representatives right there in the mobile unit. It's wonderful that their reps have language skills that match that of our clientele, the Spanish and the Haitian Creole. And a lot of people, if they're coming from countries or rural areas, they right, might not really understand how the banking system works at all. So it's a wonderful opportunity for them to learn with a trusted partner.

## Charles Gilbert, Rosenbach Law Firm of Belle Glade:
