

Dear Family: in class today, we learned about veterinarians and made x-ray artwork.

Did you know?

- Veterinarians are community helpers; they are doctors for animals.
- Veterinarians and doctors use x-rays.
- Aboriginal x-ray artwork shows bones of animals.

Ask your child:

- What does a veterinarian do?
- Tell me some tools they use.
- Explain what an x-ray shows.
- Describe how you made x-ray artwork.

Vocabulary:

- veterinarian – a doctor for animals.
- community helper – a person who helps by offering services.
- doctor – a person who treats sick people or animals.
- stethoscope – a tool. It is used by doctors. It makes sounds inside a body louder.
- Aborigine – the first people to live in an area.
- x-ray – a photograph made with a special beam. It shows what is inside something.

Activity:

Help your child to draw an outline of their hand on a piece of paper. Help them to feel the bones in their hand. Help them draw lines on their hand outline where they can feel the bones. Send the drawing to school to share with us.
