- investigate – to look closely at.
- materials – a group of things.

Activity:

With your child, take a walk outside. Talk about the many things you see in nature. Help your child to choose one item from nature. Be sure to choose a non-living object. Put it in a bag, and label it with your child's name. Send it to school to share.
