

Dear Family: In class today, we investigated flowers.

Did you know?

- Flowers are part of a plant.
- Flowers grow on the stalk of the plant.
- Flowers are a plant's tool. They make the plant's seeds.

Ask your child:

- Where did you find a flower?
- Describe the color of the flower.
- Describe the petals of the flower.

Vocabulary:

- nature – the outside world.
- flower – part of a plant. It makes fruit or seeds.
- dry – not wet.
- press – to push down firmly on something.
- preserve – to keep safe to last a long time.
- beauty – a pleasant sight to see.

Activity:

Take your child for a walk outside. Look for flowers. Count the petals on the flowers together. Write 2 numbers on a sheet of paper – first, the most petals you found; second, the least number of petals you found. Send the paper to school to share with us.
