

Digital Wallet Schedule

This Digital Wallet Schedule (“**Digital Wallet Schedule**”) is a Schedule to the Merchant Agreement and sets forth the terms and conditions applicable to the Digital Wallet Solution as defined and described herein. Capitalized terms used but not defined in this Digital Wallet Schedule are defined in the Merchant Agreement.

Digital Wallet Solution

Processor will integrate and enable alternative payment functionality with Hosted Payment Page and/or other Additional Merchant Products available from Processor (each a “**Processor Web Solution**”) which will allow end-users with electronically stored payment methods (each a “**Digital Wallet**”) the option to select and use their Digital Wallet to remit payment to Merchant (“**Digital Wallet Solution**”). Digital Wallet Solution is considered Software under the Merchant Agreement.

Features and Functionality:

- End-users who select to pay with a Digital Wallet are automatically routed to content owned or managed by the selected Digital Wallet provider to complete and/or submit certain payment data or information back to the applicable Processor Web Solution.
- The Card designated or selected using a Digital Wallet is recognized by the Processor Web Solution the same as if the end-user did not use a Digital Wallet.

Dependent Solutions. Dependent Solutions for Digital Wallet Solution include:

- Merchant Services provided to Merchant under the Merchant Agreement include at least one Processor Web Solution and all Dependent Solutions thereof

Provider Wallet Terms. By using or accessing the Digital Wallet Solution, Merchant is expressly acknowledging and agreeing to the terms, conditions, guidelines and/or other restrictions of each Digital Wallet provider whose alternative payment method is included in the Digital Wallet Solution (collectively, “**Provider Wallet Terms**”), as such may be updated from time-to-time. Provider Wallet Terms are separate from but in addition to the terms and conditions of this Digital Wallet Schedule and the Merchant Agreement. For clarity, Provider Wallet Terms which include provisions applicable to the integration or enablement of a Digital Wallet into a Processor Web Solution or other checkout payment page used or accessed by Merchant are considered applicable to Merchant, even if such integration or enablement is part of the Digital Wallet Solution provided or performed (in whole or in part) by Processor. Provider Wallet Terms are currently available at the following hyperlinks, which also include any additional URLs or webpages hyperlinked or otherwise included therein by reference. Processor provides these third-party hyperlinks as a convenience. Processor has no control over third-party sites and makes no representations about any content, products or services available at these locations. When accessing third-party websites, it is recommended that Merchant review their terms and conditions, accessibility standards, and privacy and security policies.

Merchant Responsibilities:

- Merchant represents and warrants to Processor that it will not accept payment using a Digital Wallet or otherwise use the Digital Wallet Solution for goods or services which are prohibited by any Payment Network, a Digital Wallet provider or otherwise as set forth in any Provider Wallet Terms.
- Merchant is responsible for ensuring its compliance with the Provider Wallet Terms.
- Merchant acknowledges and agrees that Processor may terminate or suspend the provision of the Digital Wallet Solution should Processor determine or reasonably suspect, in good faith, Merchant to be in violation of Provider Wallet Terms.
- Test transactions for the Digital Wallet Solution may require Merchant to (i) create its own developer account directly with each Digital Wallet Provider and (ii) obtain hardware, software, or other products and services necessary to effectuate such test transactions.
