

Hosted Payment Page Schedule

This Hosted Payment Page Schedule (“**HPP Schedule**”) is a Schedule to the Merchant Agreement and sets forth the terms and conditions applicable to the Hosted Payment Page as defined and described herein. Capitalized terms used but not defined in this HPP Schedule are defined in the Merchant Agreement or the Gateway Schedule.

Hosted Payment Page

Processor will provide or otherwise make available to Merchant a webpage with the capacity to capture payment information and/or other data entered by end-users (“**Hosted Payment Page**”), which when integrated with Merchant Services and Gateway from Processor enables Merchant to accept various forms of Card payments submitted by end-users. Each Hosted Payment Page and any domains obtained or used by Processor in connection thereof, even those obtained at Merchant’s request, shall be considered PNC Property.

Hosted Payment Page Features and Functionality

- End-users can remit payments to Merchant using a Card without using or registering an online account or otherwise requiring log-in information.
- Integration of each Hosted Payment Page with the Gateway to enable encrypted transmission of Transaction Data and other necessary information associated with payments initiated using the Hosted Payment Page
- Hosted Payment Page can be used in connection with Merchant Systems' existing webpages
- Each Hosted Payment Page will include Merchant’s Elected Card Types.
- Merchant can elect to include prompts for certain payment account information and/or other identifying data components, such as invoice number, account number, customer number, zip code, etc. (“**Payor Identifiers**”) and designate certain fields to display or as required to be entered by the end-user.
- Merchant can elect payment confirmation be automatically generated and sent to end-users to the email entered or otherwise displayed on the Hosted Payment Page
- Reporting fields for reconciliation include Payor Identifiers
- Merchant can elect to enable alternative payments optionality that are available from Processor as an Additional Merchant Product (e.g. Digital Wallet).

Dependent Solutions.

- Merchant Services provided to Merchant under the Merchant Agreement include Gateway, and all the Dependent Solutions identified in the Gateway Schedule.

Merchant Obligations and Responsibilities

- Merchant is exclusively responsible for ensuring Payor Identifiers do not include highly sensitive personal identifying information, including Protected Health Information, full primary account data, etc. unless expressly agreed to by Processor in writing.
- Merchant acknowledges that payment confirmations generated by any Hosted Payment Page may not include itemization or details. Merchant is responsible for ensuring end-users are provided with receipts which include itemization and details required by Applicable Law and/or the Network Rules.
